RESURFACING OF CGH CARPARK Please be aware that the work on resurfacing the carpark at CGH will commence next week and therefore access will be restricted. Initially new kerbstones will be laid at the far end of the carpark and therefore the back end will be coned off. Once these kerbstones are laid it is very important that nobody attempts to drive over them to park on the grass as it will damage them. This will also apply once the concrete has set, so this area will be 'out of bounds' for parking in the future. The following week the carpark will be closed completely for a number of days as it is resurfaced and new white lining is applied. When the newly refurbished carpark is opened, you will note the current entrance and exit will have been reversed, ie we will now enter through opening nearest CGH and exit through the opening nearest Downside Bridge Road. New signs will be put in place to remind everybody of this change and we will be grateful if everybody take care when entering and leaving the carpark. Particularly as there are a number of casual users, not related to the church, that may continue to use the carpark and thereby present a hazard.
