**SUSPENSION OF PRESENTATION TO BENEFICE OF COBHAM AND STOKE D'ABERNON** : as a first step in the separation of the parishes of Cobham and Stoke D'Abernon into two single parish benefices, as requested in April by both PCCs, the Bishop, after consulting interested parties has suspended the presentation to the benefice to allow time for the process of pastoral reorganisation to proceed. This process could take a number of months as it requires further consultations. In anticipation of the separation, Revd. Dr. Mike Branscombe will be installed as Priest in Charge (although will normally be known as "Vicar") on September 6th until the separation process is complete, at which time he will be formerly inducted as the Vicar of the Parish of Cobham.
