ECUMENICAL DISCUSSION GROUPS LENT 2018.

Better Together? All about relationships – in the church and within family and society. BISHOP OF GUILDFORD'S LENT CHALLENGE The Bishop of Guildford's lent challenge, 2018, uses six words, read, learn, pray, tell, serve and give, to guide reflections throughout lent, with the opportunity to donate to the work of the Anglican Communion Fund reaching children with disabilities in Tanzania, and the Bishop of Guildford's foundation. Last year's appeal raised more than £20,000 which was shared between the two causes. Booklets detailing the challenge are available in the porch.

AVENUE OF REMEMBRANCE Following the public consultation in September 2017 work will start on site during the week commencing 29 January. All the existing cherry trees will be removed and the soil will be improved prior to planting young replacement cherries. A meadow strip will be then sowed underneath the young trees. Planting of the 46 new trees will commence in the week beginning 12 February subject to weather conditions. The meadow will be sown in the spring.
